### **Partners and Communities Together (PACT) Update**

Kent Police, Westerham Town Council, KCC Community Wardens, Sevenoaks District Council and local Community Groups have been meeting regularly for the past 6 months to address concerns of crime and anti-social behaviour reported by residents of Westerham. Together we put together an action plan to take forward actions. Following on from the most recent meeting on 5 June 2018 together we have:-

- Westerham TC have purchased a mobile CCTV camera to put in hot spot locations
- Community Speed Watch has been implemented
- Police have done over 5 nights of proactive action
- Patrols have been heightened in the areas most reported
- Warning letters and Behaviour Agreements have been served by SDC and Police to individuals
- Talks on safety have been delivered to schools and sea cadets by Community Warden
- Joint visits have taken place by Wardens, SDC and PCSO



- A community event in the evening was held on 23 May
- Working with Town Council on local concerns on Social Media
- Substance Misuse Youth Worker has visited sites where reports of drug and alcohol misuse have been reported

This has had a positive result with fewer reports of anti-social behaviour, however we are still keen to hear from residents or businesses if there are ongoing issues.
