Our Town – Our Future:

How might Westerham look in 2035? Where **might** new houses, a new industrial site, a bypass be sited? If you want to know how your town might develop, then make sure that you are at one of the sessions taking place during the summer where you can find out more – and learn how you can make your views known. Sevenoaks District Council are publishing their first draft of the Local Plan which sets out those sites within Westerham – and the rest of the district – which might be suitable for development. The fact that sites are included in this draft does not necessarily mean that they will be in the final version which will go to the Planning Inspector, an official responsible to the Secretary of State for Housing, Communities and Local Government, who will decide if the plan is acceptable.

At this stage SDC is asking statutory bodies (eg Highways Agency, Environment Agency, Kent County Council) for their views on whether the developments are feasible, **but they also want the community's view. Consultation opens on 16th July and ends 10th September**

Street lights obscured by vegetation

We need your help to keep our street lights effective by ensuring vegetation such as trees, shrubs and hedges **from your property** or land **does not obscure street lights** so that they can shine effectively onto the highway.

Street lights obscured by vegetation will be reported to Kent County Council as per the Highways Act 1980 that states, "where a hedge, tree or shrub obstructs or interferes with the light from a public lamp the competent authority (i.e. Kent County Council), may by notice either to the owner of the hedge, tree or shrub or to the occupier of the land on which it is growing, require him within 14 days from the notice to lop or cut it as to remove the cause of the danger, obstruction or interference".
