- bus services run by bus operators in Kent (KCC does not run individual bus services)



KCC will use any feedback you give in this form about bus services in their regular Quality Bus Partnerships with bus operators and district, town and parish councils. The feedback you provide will be discussed with Kent's bus companies to highlight any issues, or passed to the Traffic Commissioner (who regulates bus operators and their services) if the same issues keep occurring.
