How you can help? You can play an important role in the fight against fly-tippers by making sure you only use registered waste carriers to take waste from your home or business. If you use a nonregistered waste collector and your waste ends up being dumped in the District, you too could face a fine or prosecution. You can check if someone has a license on the Environment Agency's website:
