Information on street cleaning from Sevenoaks District Council

Sevenoaks District Council undertake daily litter picks and bin emptying and weekly mechanical cleans. For all rural roads across the district they are mechanically cleaned and manually litter picked 6-monthly.

SDC have included as part of the weekly mechanical cleans, with each week the vehicles going further along the routes -the A25, the A 233 towards Westerham Hill, the B2026 (Hosey Hill) and Goodley Stock Road). The team will also target high litter areas along these routes that are identified for additional cleans.
