Bruce's Doggy Day Care, Land South of Force Green Lane, Westerham TN16 2DN

Non-material amendment to 20/01170/FUL.

WTC objects to this application as it is a major amendment that goes against the reason for the condition having been set in the first place. It was initially acknowledged by both KCC Highways and SDC Planning that there were road safety concerns which should be dealt with prior to construction work/or use commencing. The issues relating to road safety are still there, and relate just as much to the initial construction phase as they do to when the business is up and running. Therefore WTC believes that the wording of the condition should remain the same.

First floor and 2 storey rear extension. Replacement porch canopy to rear. Internal alterations. Alterations to roof. Alterations to fenestration.

WTC supports the application subject to the 50% rule.

Squerryes Sandpit Covers Farm Westerham Road Westerham Kent

Stabilisation and restoration of Covers Farm Quarry using imported engineering materials to restore the site to grassland, including landscape planting and an ecological receptor area together with a temporary road and ancillary buildings.
