	 SE/23/02607/HOUSE 1 Westways, Westerham TN16 1TT Part double storey side and rear extension with rear dormer extension. Loft conversion. Alterations to fenestration. Rooflights. WTC objects to the application on the following grounds: - The overlarge extension creates a terracing effect between buildings thereby going against LS3 and BM3 of Westerham Design Statement. The plans are incorrect as the current plan clearly shows an outbuilding (garage) which is not there and the front, rear and side 	

elevations do not match the current building.

- The number of bathrooms suggests a future use as an HMO.
- There is no EV charging point on the plans.
