Kent County Council are responsible for maintaining the highways for our parish. Let them know about any potholes or problems on the roads via their online reporting tool, which will help KCC to schedule repairs as quickly as possible.

You can report non-urgent issues that are impacting the highways online including:

- street light faults (for KCC owned lights)
- potholes
- drainage
- traffic signal faults
- overgrown vegetation (including hedges and grass).
